

**Mounting:**

The base of this antenna is a 3/8-24 mounting stud and can be affixed to a base mount for 1/4 wave vertical use or a dipole mount such as the Intellitron AA-1602 Dipole Bracket for horizontal use.

*Note: AA-1602 Dipole Bracket is not suitable for a 40-meter or 30-meter dipole configuration with the TA-1325.*

**Tuning:**

For proper whip extension, please follow the chart below as a reference:

$$\text{Length (feet)} = 234 / \text{Frequency MHz}$$

$$\text{Length (inches)} = 2808 / \text{Frequency MHz}$$

**Note:**

*The information in the table above is a reference. SWR can be affected by surroundings, mounting method, and the height above ground. Adjustments may be required to achieve the lowest SWR.*

**Installation:**

The TA-1325 antenna can be used vertically or horizontally to achieve the desired polarization. We suggest terminating the coax feedline exit at a right angle to the element/base. When extended, the antenna will become flexible, so use caution when assembling and tuning. Use eye protection during this process.
